ORDER:

In the reference 7th read above, Government have issued orders in pursuance of the Sports Policy declared in G.O.Ms.No.84, Youth Advancement Tourism and Culture (Sports) Department, Dt: 04-05-2000, wherein orders were issued extending two percent (2%) Sports reservation in future direct recruitment in Government at all levels. The guidelines required were issued for governing such appointments.

2) In the reference 9th read above, the Secretary to Govt., General Administration (Services & HRM) Dept. has stated that the Secretary, Andhra Pradesh Public Service Commission, Hyderabad had informed that since vertical reservations are already provided up to 50% to the social categories i.e. SCs, STs, BCs, the Commission is of the opinion that reservations to sports persons should be horizontal but not vertical.

3) Further, in the event of non-availability of eligible sports persons, the posts reserved for them should be deemed to be allotted to open competition in the same recruitment. Hence, the Commission advised to amend the orders issued in Clause (xvii) of the G.O.Ms.No.74, YAT&C(Sports)Dept., dated:09.08.2012 accordingly. The Secretary to Govt. (Services & HRM), General Administration Dept. has requested to examine the issue by keeping the advice of the Commission in view and take appropriate decision.

4) The Government after careful examination of the matter hereby issue the following amendment to G.O.Ms.No.74, YAT&C (Sports) Department, Dt:09.08.2012.

- 5) The following notification will be published in the Andhra Pradesh Gazette :

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the constitution of India and of all other powers here into enabling the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby makes the following amendment to G.O.Ms.No.74, YAT&C (Sports) Department, Dt:09-08-2012.

AMENDMENT

In G.O.Ms.No.74, YAT&C (Sports) Department, Dt:09-08-2012 the guideline under Clause No.(xvii) shall be substituted with the following:

(xvii) Provide 2% reservations to meritorious sportsperson horizontally in Direct recruitment in the existing 100 roster points as per Rule-22(2)(e) of the A.P.State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1996, 48th and 98th points meant for Open Competition shall be earmarked to reservation under Sports quota in Direct recruitment as issued earlier in G.O.Ms.No.74, YAT&C (Sports) Department, Dt:09.08.2012. Further, in the event of non availability of eligible sportspersons, the points reserved for them should be deemed to be allotted to open competition in the same recruitment.

- 6) The Andhra Pradesh Public Service Commission have conveyed their concurrence to the above guidelines in their letter 8th read above.

- 7) The General Administration (Services-D) Department shall take necessary further action to amend A.P. State and Subordinate Service Rules (1996) and enable all recruiting departments to implement this reservation for eligible sportspersons expeditiously.
